

2020 Summer Da\$h Rules

Entry and Draw Rules

- All pre-entries must be postmarked by Wednesday June 24th. Entries after this date must pay a late fee of \$20 per rider, per office visit. Late entries will be taken until the first horse runs each day.
- On-line entries will be accepted via www.EBarrelRacing.com. See the on-line website link for more on-line entry info, deadlines & details.
- Horse or rider substitutions will be allowed until the first horse runs each day with a \$10 change fee.
- Vet/Doctor releases will be accepted until 5pm Thursday July 9th. Full refund (less the processing fee) with valid release. Fax # for vet-outs is 806-488-2146 or email to: office@CBTBarrelRacing.com.
- Open arena will be offered from 7am-8:45am Saturday. There is no charge for open arena. Absolutely NO barrels can be set up during open arena.
- Riding slots will be offered Saturday from 9am-1pm. Riding slots will be offered as follows: 10-minute/4 rider limit, 15-minute/6 rider limit or 25-minute/12 rider limit (no ponying or leading horses). Slots are \$15 each. Limited reservations for riding slots will be taken by telephone Wednesday, July 8th from 6pm-8pm (TX time) by calling 806-488-2144. Phone-in reservations MUST be paid for in the office 1 hour prior, or spot will be sold, no exceptions! Selling of riding slots will be limited to 3 spots per person on the phone or in line at the entry office.
- If you are a current BBR member and would like this race to count toward their finals, you must provide us with your membership number prior to running.
- If you are a current WPRA member and would like to be included in the WPRA results, you must provide us with your membership number prior to running.
- If you want to enter the Future Fortunes incentive, your horse must be enrolled in the Future Fortunes program (www.FutureFortunesInc.com for details), you MUST check the sidepot box, include the registration papers with your entry, fill out the separate FF entry form (link is on our website or entry forms will be on-site) and enter using your horse's registered name (no barn names accepted). The FF open incentive is only available on Sunday. FF books close at 9am Sunday, no exceptions! All FF paperwork must be in office when books close for you to be considered an entry.
- Entering this race gives the official photographer, Boaz Elkes, permission to take pictures of and during all contestant's runs. Photographs will be made available for purchase. Furthermore, CBT Barrel Racing, has the right to use contestant's pictures for sponsor and race promotion purposes.

Running Rules

- In the event of a timer failure, a rerun will be issued. If a contestant decides to rerun, any penalties from the original run will be assessed.
- Horse/rider combos must compete in the order posted in the draw. A contestant will be given 3 gate calls. A contestant's first gate call is checking in with the gate person. When the announcer calls you into the arena, that will be your 2nd call. If you miss your run you will be considered a no time. If you compete out of order, you will be given a no time.
- If you get off pattern, do not circle a barrel more than once. Keep the ground as good and fair as possible. Excessive abusive of arena time could result in a fine.
- A barrel that falls to the ground and has to be reset before the next runner will be considered a knocked down barrel and will result in a no time.

Dress Code

- Dress code is required. This includes western hat or helmet, a long-sleeved shirt, pants and boots or riding shoes with heels. If contestant breaks dress code, they will receive a no time.
- There will be a hat fine of \$5 if the arena staff collects your hat. Fine is due to the staff member that collects your hat.

Complaints

- A contestant wishing to point out a discrepancy or file a complaint must do so with a CBT Barrel Racing official, accompanied by a \$50 fee. All complaints must be filed in a timely manner to be considered. If CBT Barrel Racing sides with the contestant on the discrepancy, the \$50 will be returned, however, if the organization disagrees with the complaint the \$50 will not be returned.
- The CBT Barrel Racing official's decision is final!

Open Payback and Race Format

- The open will be a 5D race with ½ second splits.
- 75% of entry fees will go into purse. Of the purse money, 60% goes to that Day's Race and 40% to the Main Race.
- 100% of added money will go into purse. \$1000 added to the Main Race (race #3) and \$1250 added to each of the Day Races (Saturday is race #1 and Sunday is race #2)
- Payback scale will be: 1D--30%, 2D--25%, 3D--20%, 4D--15%, 5D--10%, with a modified BBR suggested payoff percentages for the actual placings.
- Results will be calculated at the end of each day for that Day's race (Saturday is race #1 and Sunday is race #2). The Main race results will be calculated at the end of Sunday's open and will include all times from race #1 and #2. (Ex: If Saturday has 200 runners and Sunday has 175 runners, then the Main race will have 375 runners.) Runners that run more than one day will have more than one time in the Main race and can win multiple checks.
- Any unpaid money because of un-filled divisions will go to the winner of the 1D.
- For all other rules refer to BBR/NBHA/WPRA rules.
- A special Mother-Child sidepot will be held on Saturday. Please visit the on-site office for rules and entry forms. Mother-Child sidepot awards courtesy of Farmers Insurance, Ashley Little Agency.

Awards

- Choice of certificates from the merchants in our Choice of Champions award program will be given to the Top 5 of each division of the Main Race. 1st place will win a \$100 certificate, 2nd place will win an \$80 certificate, 3rd place will win a \$60 certificate, 4th place will win a \$40 certificate and 5th place will win a \$20 certificate.
- Any ties for awards will be broken first by presence or representation and secondly by draw of a chip.

SuperSized 4D sidepot

- Open to any entered contestant. Can only be entered as a carry-over from your Open 5D or KK run. No late fee to add the sidepot on-site.
- The sidepot is a 4D, paid back on a Pro-D 'new/trial' payback scale. \$135 extra entry fee (\$200 total), 90% payback. Saturday and Sunday will be paid back separately. You can enter one or both days.

PBRIP (paint horse incentive)

- Enter on-site upon arrival. Visit <https://apha.com/pbrip/about-pbrip/> for more information. \$250 added money sponsored by APHA.

Facility Rules

- Parking areas will be designated by the Amarillo Tri-State Expo.
- No dogs allowed inside the Amarillo National Center.
- Stalls will be sold on a first-come, first-serve basis at \$25 per night through the stall office. You will be required to purchase at least 2 bags of shavings per stall from the facility. Stalls will open Friday at 1pm.
- RV hookups are available through the stall office, upon arrival.
- Coggins will be check on ALL horses entering the grounds.

CoVid-19 issues

- If the CoVid-19 affects anyone before or during race day and they need to draw out, entry fees can be rolled to a future CBT Barrel Race (contact the office for specifics).
