

## 2022 Summer DaSh Rules

### Entry and Draw Rules

- All pre-entries must be postmarked by April 20th. Entries after this date must pay a late fee of \$20 per rider, per office visit. Late entries will be taken until the first horse runs each day.
- Horse or rider substitutions will be allowed until the first horse runs each day with a \$10 change fee.
- Vet/Doctor releases will be accepted until 5pm Thursday May 5th. Full refund (less the processing fee) with valid release. Fax # for vet-outs is 806-488-2146, e-mail address is: [office@cbtbarrelracing.com](mailto:office@cbtbarrelracing.com).
- Riding slots will be offered Friday from 7pm-9pm and Saturday from 9am-11am. Friday riding slots MUST be pre-purchased using the riding slot entry form posted on the website or included with our February mailout. Friday slot details on posted on the Friday slot entry form. Saturday riding slots will be offered as follows: 10-minute/4 rider limit, 15-minute/6 rider limit or 25-minute/12 rider limit. Slots are \$15 each. Saturday slots will be sold on-site ONLY, no exceptions starting at 8am Saturday! Selling of riding slots will be limited to 3 spots per person in line at the entry office. No ponying or leading horses during a riding slot.
- Pole bending exhibitions will be offered Saturday May 7th immediately after the open barrels. Pole bending exhibitions will go on sale Saturday morning at 8am and will be limited to 50 exhibitions total. Exhibitions will be \$5 each and limited to 3 per rider.
- Entering this race gives the official photographer, Boaz Elkes, permission to take pictures of and during all contestant's runs. Photographs will be made available for purchase via Facebook Messenger. Furthermore, CBT Barrel Racing, has the right to use contestant's pictures for sponsor and race promotion purposes.

### Running Rules

- In the event of a timer failure, a re-run will be offered. Penalties from the original run will NOT be applied to the re-run.
- Horse/rider combos must compete in the order posted in the draw. A contestant will be given 3 gate calls. A contestant's first gate call is checking in with the gate person. When the announcer calls you into the arena, that will be your 2nd call. If you miss your run you will be considered a no time. If you compete out of order, you will be given a no time.
- If you get off pattern, do not circle a barrel more than once. Keep the ground as good and fair as possible. Excessive abusive of arena time could result in a fine.
- A barrel or pole that falls to the ground and has to be reset before the next runner will be considered knocked down and will result in a no time.

### Dress Code

- Dress code is required. This includes western hat or helmet, a long-sleeved shirt, pants and boots or riding shoes with heels. If contestant breaks dress code, they will receive a no time. There will be a hat fine of \$5 if the arena staff collects your hat. Fine is due to the staff member that collects your hat.

### Complaints

- A contestant wishing to point out a discrepancy or file a complaint must do so with a CBT Barrel Racing official, accompanied by a \$50 fee. All complaints must be filed in a timely manner to be considered. If CBT Barrel Racing sides with the contestant on the discrepancy, the \$50 will be returned, however, if the organization disagrees with the complaint the \$50 will not be returned. The CBT Barrel Racing official's decision is final!

### Open Payback and Race Format, Open Payback and Awards

- The open will be a 5D race with 1/2 second splits. 75% of entry fees will go into purse. Of the purse money, 80% goes to that Day's Race and 20% to the KoolSpeed Bonus race. 100% of added money will go into purse. \$1000 added to the combined race (race #3) and \$1500 added to each of the Day Races (Saturday is race #1 and Sunday is race #2).
- Day race payback scale will be: 1D--30%, 2D--25%, 3D--20%, 4D--15%, 5D--10%, with a modified BBR suggested payoff percentages for the actual placings. Results will be calculated at the end of each day for that Day's race (Saturday is race #1 and Sunday is race #2).
- The KoolSpeed Bonus race results will be calculated at the end of Sunday's open and will include all times from race #1 and #2. (Ex: If Saturday has 150 runners and Sunday has 175 runners, then the Bonus race will have 325 runners.) Runners that run more than one day will have more than one time in the Bonus race and can win multiple checks. The combined race payback will be equal payout in the Ds and equal payout in the placings (ie: bonus bucks). Checks and 'choice' of awards will be award to the top 5 in each D of the KoolSpeed Bonus race. Award choice will be given first on presence and secondly in order of placing.
- Certificates from the merchants in our Choice of Champions award program will be given to the Top 5 of each division of each day (\$50 gift certificate to the merchant of their choice) and \$100 gift certificates will be part of the top 5 in the combined race award choice.
- The winner of each D from each day will win an award choice from Classic Equine.
- Any ties for awards will be broken first by presence or representation and secondly by draw of a chip.

### 3D Youth

- The 12 & under youth will be a 3D with full-second splits. Age is as of race day.
- \$25 entry fee, 80% payback. Youth D-winner awards & \$100 added money sponsored by Cattle Drive Apartments in Canyon Texas.
- Youth will run at noon and on Saturday only. The youth's run(s) can be carry-overs into the Open 5D and/or the SuperSized sidepot with the appropriate paid fees.

### Open 4D Poles

- Open 4D poles will have full second splits, 80% payback, \$40 entry fee. Awards will be given to D winners.

### SuperSized 4D sidepot

- Open to any entered contestant. Can only be entered as a carry-over from your Open 5D or Youth 3D run. No late fee to add the sidepot on-site.
- The sidepot is a 4D, paid back on a Pro-D payback scale (Progressive-Divisional). The Pro-D is a straight pay for the 1D/2D with 3D and 4D divisions. Payback is split 65% to the 1D/2D, 20% to the 3D and 15% to the 4D. See previous year's results for payback examples.
- \$135 extra entry fee (\$200 total), 90% payback. Saturday and Sunday will be paid back separately. You can enter one or both days.

### \$1500 added XIT rodeo qualifier sidepot

- \$50 entry fee per horse. Enter on-site, anytime before your run, with no late fee. Weekend sidepot is an equal payout 4D. Rodeo run, held in conjunction with the 2022 XIT rodeo, is a straight pay race, limited to the Top 18 qualifiers from this sidepot. Details can be found on-site at the XIT entry booth.

### All-Around awards • The fastest combined time of a horse/rider combo that competes in Saturday's barrels and Sunday's poles will win a our all-around award.

### Mother-Child team sidepot

- Offered on Sunday, in honor of Mother's Day. Mother/Child teams must come to the office and fill out an entry form (also on the website). If a team member(s) are not already entered in Sunday's open, the rider(s) can compete in the sidepot only for a \$5 ground fee. The team members times will be added together for a team time and the fastest 10 teams receive awards.

### Facility Rules

- Parking areas will be designated by the Amarillo Tri-State Expo. No dogs allowed inside the Amarillo National Center.
- Stalls will be sold on a first-come, first-serve basis at \$25 per night through the stall office. You will be required to purchase at least 2 bags of shavings per stall from the facility. Stalls will open Friday at 1pm.
- RV hookups are available through the stall office, upon arrival.
- Coggins will be checked on ALL horses entering the grounds.

### Co-Approvals

- Future Fortunes - Visit <http://www.futurefortunesinc.com/> for more information. FF entries need to be marked on the original entry form. All Future Fortunes paperwork (FF entry form and registration papers) MUST be turned into the office BEFORE making your run. You can turn paperwork in on-site or before race day (email or fax).
- Select Stallion Stakes - Visit <http://selectstallionstakes.com/> for race information. To be eligible for SSS bonus money, you must be entered in Saturday's race and use your horse's correct registered name.
- BBR - If you are a current BBR member and would like this race to count toward their finals, you must provide us with your membership number prior to running. If you wish to become a member you may purchase your membership in the entry office.
- WPRA - If you are a current WPRA member and would like to be included in the WPRA results, you must provide us with your membership number prior to running.
- KK Run For Vegas - Visit [www.KKRunForVegas.com](http://www.KKRunForVegas.com) for qualifier information. Your paid KK runs are paid carry overs into the Sunday Open 5D barrels and the Sunday Open 4D poles. Anything else will need to be entered with CBT.
- Run For The Bonus - Visit [www.BonusRaceFinals.com](http://www.BonusRaceFinals.com) for qualifier information. No entry fee. Number of qualifiers is based on the number of entries. Only the Saturday and Sunday 'day' races are qualifiers.
- Team Fearless - Visit [TeamFearlessBarrelRacing.com](http://TeamFearlessBarrelRacing.com) for Team Fearless information.
- WCRA - CBT is an Alliance Partner of the WCRA. For details visit [www.WCRArodeo.com](http://www.WCRArodeo.com).
- PBRIP - Enter on-site upon arrival, anytime before your run. Visit <https://apha.com/pbrrip/about-pbrrip/> for more information. \$3500 added money sponsored by the Texas Paint Horse Breeders Association (TPHBA). \$2500 will go into the PBRIP 4D (1/2-second splits) sidepot that is paid out over both days, you can enter once or twice. Entry fee is \$55 a run. \$1000 will be paid out to the 3 fastest Texas-bred paints. For the Texas-bred incentive, a horse can only place once (but can run twice) and the rider has to be a TPHBA member.

### CoVid-19 issues

- If the CoVid-19 affects anyone before or during race day and they need to draw out, entry fees can be rolled to a future CBT Barrel Race (contact the office for specifics). Office contact MUST be made BEFORE your scheduled run in order for credit to be given.
