

2017 Double Da\$h Rules

Entry and Draw Rules

- All pre-entries must be postmarked by Friday August 18th. Entries after this date must pay a late fee of \$20 per rider, per office visit. Late entries will be taken until the first horse runs each day.
- Online entries via RodeoGo.com will be accepted from August 21st until 9am September 2nd.
- Horse OR Rider substitutions will be allowed until the first horse runs each day.
- Vet/Doctor releases will be accepted until 5pm Thursday August 31st. A full refund (less the \$20 processing fee) with valid release will be issued.
- Riding slots will be offered Saturday from 11am-2pm and Sunday from 9:30am-11am. A riding slot is a 25-minute open arena session with barrels, limited to 12 riders per session (no ponying or leading horses). Individual slots are \$15 each and must be paid for before taken. All slots will be sold on site. Limited purchase of 3 per person each office visit.
- If you are a current BBR member and would like this race to count toward their finals, you must provide us with your membership number prior to running. If you wish to become a member you may purchase your membership in the office.
- If you are a current WPRA member and would like to be included in the WPRA results, you must provide us with your membership number prior to running.
- If your horse is enrolled in the Future Fortunes incentive, you **MUST** check the sidepot box, include the registration papers with your entry and enter using your horse's registered name (no barn names accepted). FF open incentive is only available on Saturday. Other FF forms will need to be filled out on-site.

Running Rules

- In the event of a timer failure, a re-run will be issued. If a contestant decides to rerun, any penalties from the original run will be assessed.
- Horse/rider combos must compete in the order posted in the draw. A contestant will be given 3 gate calls. If you miss your run you will be considered a no time. If you compete out of order, you will be given a no time.
- If you get off pattern, do not circle a barrel more than once. Keep the ground as good and fair as possible. Excessive abusive of arena time could result in a fine.

Dress Code

- Dress code is required. This includes western hat or helmet, a long-sleeved shirt (collar is optional), pants and boots or riding shoes with heels. If contestant breaks dress code, they will receive a no time.
- There will be a lost hat fine of \$5 if the arena staff collects your hat. Fine payable to the staff member that collects your hat.

Complaints

- A contestant wishing to point out a discrepancy or file a complaint must do so with a CBT Productions official, accompanied by a \$50 fee. All complaints must be filed in a timely manner to be considered. If the officials side with the contestant on the discrepancy, the \$50 will be returned, however, if the officials disagree with the complaint the \$50 will not be returned. The CBT official's decision is final!

Open Payback, Awards and Race Format

- The open will be a 5D race with ½ second splits.
- 75% of entry fees will go into purse. 100% of added money will go into purse. \$500 added to the Main Race (race #3) & \$1250 added to each of the Day Races (Saturday is race #1 & Sunday is race #2). Of the purse money, 50% goes to that Day's Race and 50% to the Main Race.
- Payback scale will be: 1D--30%, 2D--25%, 3D--20%, 4D--15%, 5D--10%, with modified BBR suggested payoff percentages for the actual placings.
- Results will be calculated at the end of each day for that Day's race (Saturday is race #1 and Sunday is race #2). The Main race results will be calculated at the end of Sunday's open and will include all times from race #1 and #2. (Ex: If Saturday has 150 runners, Sunday has 200 runners, then the Main race will have 350 runners.) Runners that run more than one day will have more than one time in the Main race and can win multiple checks.
- Any unpaid money because of un-filled divisions will go to the winner of the 1D.
- For all other rules refer to BBR/NBHA rules.
- Award choice will be given to the Top 4 of each division of the Main Race (race #3). Winners present for the awards will be get to pick their award, others will be mailed.
- Any ties for awards will be broken by the draw of a chip.

3D Youth

- The youth will be a 3D with full-second splits. Age limit is 15. Age is as of race day.
- \$25 entry fee, 80% payback. Average awards will be given on a 3D scale. Any ties will be broken by the draw of a chip.
- Youth will run after #100 in the open. The youth's run(s) can be youth-only runs or carry-overs into the open with payment of the appropriate fees.

3D Buckle or Bust sidepot

- No additional entry fee. Contestants must be entered in the Open 5D.
- Sidepot is limited to **ONLY** those contestants that have never won a barrel racing belt buckle. Eligibility is self-determined and on the 'honor system'. Contestants wishing to be included in the sidepot **MUST** circle the appropriate answer on their entry blank.
- 3D Average buckles to be awarded (full-second splits per one run). Any ties will be broken by the draw of a chip.
