2019 Double Da\$h Rules

Entry and Draw Rules

• All pre-entries must be postmarked by Wednesday August 14th. Entries after this date must pay a late fee of \$20 per rider, per office visit. Late entries will be taken until the first horse runs each day.

• Online entries via EBarrelRacing.com will be accepted until 5pm August 29th

(late fee applies after 8-14).

• Horse or rider substitutions will be allowed until the first horse runs each day with a \$10 change fee.

• Vet/Doctor releases will be accepted until 5pm Thursday August 29th. A full refund (less the \$20 processing fee) with valid release will be issued.

• Riding slots will be offered Saturday from 9am–1pm. Each hour riding slots will be offered as follows: 10-minute/4 rider limit, 15-minute/6 rider limit and 25-minute/12 rider limit (no ponying or leading horses). Slots are \$15 each. All slots will be sold on site. Limited purchase of 3 per person each office visit.

• If you are a current BBR member and would like this race to count toward their finals, you must provide us with your membership number prior to running. If you wish to become a member you may purchase your membership in the office.

• If you are a current WPRA member and would like to be included in the WPRA results, you must provide us with your membership number prior to running.

• If you want to enter the Future Fortunes incentive, your horse must be enrolled in the Future Fortunes program (www.FutureFortunesInc.com for details), you MUST check the sidepot box, include the registration papers with your entry, fill out the separate FF entry form (link is on our website or entry forms will be on-site) and enter using your horse's registered name (no barn names accepted). The FF open incentive is only available on Saturday. FF books close at 2pm Saturday, no exceptions! All FF paperwork must be in office when books close for you to be considered an entry.

\$500 added 'Main' race (race #3) consists of all runs from race #1 and #2

• Entering this race gives the official photographer & videographer permission to take pictures/videos of and during all contestant's runs. Photographs & videos will be made available for purchase. Furthermore, CBT Barrel Racing, has the right to use contestant's pictures/videos for sponsor and race promotion purposes.

• CBT Barrel Racing reserves the right to refuse any entry.

Running Rules

• In the event of a timer failure, a re-run will be issued. If a contestant decides to rerun, any penalties from the original run will be assessed.

• Horse/rider combos must compete in the order posted in the draw. A contestant will be given 3 gate calls. If you miss your run you will considered a no time. If you compete out of order, you will be given a no time.

• If you get off pattern, do not circle a barrel more than once. Keep the ground as good and fair as possible. Excessive abusive of arena time could result in a fine.

Dress Code

• Dress code is required. This includes western hat or helmet, a long-sleeved shirt (collar is optional), pants and boots or riding shoes with heels. If contestant breaks dress code, they will receive a no time.

• There will be a lost hat fine of \$5 if the arena staff collects your hat. Fine payable to the staff member that collects your hat.

Complaints

• A contestant wishing to point out a discrepancy or file a complaint must do so with a CBT official, accompanied by a \$50 fee. All complaints must be filed in a timely manner to be considered. If the officials side with the contestant on the discrepancy, the \$50 will be returned, however, if the officials disagree with the complaint the \$50 will not be returned. The CBT official's decision is final!

Open Payback, Awards and Race Format

• The open will be a 5D race with ½ second splits.

• 75% of entry fees will go into purse (after \$1 per run is taken out for the Run For The Bonus qualifier). 100% of added money will go into purse. \$500 added to the Main Race (race #3) & \$1500 added to each of the Day Races (Saturday is race #1 & Sunday is race #2). Of the purse money, 50% goes to that Day's Race and 50% to the Main Race.

• Payback scale will be: 1D--30%, 2D--25%, 3D--20%, 4D--15%, 5D--10%, with modified BBR suggested payoff percentages for the actual placings

- Results will be calculated at the end of each day for that Day's race (Saturday is race #1 and Sunday is race #2). The Main race results will be calculated at the end of Sunday's open and will include all times from race #1 and #2. (Ex: If Saturday has 150 runners, Sunday has 200 runners, then the Main race will have 350 runners.) Runners that run more than one day will have more than one time in the Main race and can win multiple checks.
- Any unpaid money because of un-filled divisions will go to the winner of the 1D.
- For all other rules refer to BBR/NBHA/WPRA/KK Run For Vegas rules.

Awards

• Choice of certificates from the merchants in our Choice of Champions award program will be given to the Top 5 of each division of the Main Race. 1st place will win a \$100 certificate, 2nd place will win an \$80 certificate, 3rd place will win a \$60 certificate, 4th place will win a \$40 certificate and 5th place will win a \$20 certificate.

• Any ties for awards will be broken first by presence or notified representation and secondly by draw of a chip.

3D Youth

• The youth will be a 3D with full-second splits. Age limit is 15. Age is as of race day.

• \$25 entry fee, 80% payback. Average award necklaces to D winners will be awarded.

• Youth will run not before 1:30pm on Saturday and not before 9:30am Sunday. The youth's run(s) can be carry-overs into the open with the appropriate paid fees. Those running the in KK Run For Vegas Qualifier on Sunday can carry-over to the youth, if they are 15 or under and with the appropriate paid fees.

KK Run For Vegas Qualifier

• Know their rules (listed on their website)! The dress code, hat fine and some others are different. For the qualifier, their rules apply! Revolution Barrel Racing finals qualifier sanctioned sidepot

- Open to any RBR member. Membership can be pre-purchased via www.RevolutionRaces.com or purchased on-site. Or a day pass can be purchased.
- The sidepot is a 4D with 1/2 second splits. \$150 entry fee, 80% payback. Saturday and Sunday will be combined into one payout. Payout will completed by RBR.
- The sidepot can be entered as a carry-over from your Open run(s) or it can be a separate run. Any runners not carrying over from the open will run at the end of the day race.
