2025 Double Da\$h Rules

Entry and Draw Rules

- All entries will be completed via www.SaddleBook.com. Pre-entries are due August 27th. Entries after this date must pay a late fee of \$20 per rider. Late entries will be taken until the first horse runs each day.
- Vet/Doctor releases will be accepted until 5pm Thursday September 4th. Full refund (less the processing fee) with valid release. Fax # for vet-outs is 806-488-2146, e-mail address is: office@cbtbarrelracing.com.
- After the draw has been posted but before competing, on-site horse or rider substitutions will be allowed with a \$10 change fee. Some entry changes, before the draw is completed, can be made by contestants via SaddleBook without a fee. Some entry changes, made before the draw is posted, can also avoid change fees by emailing office@cbtbarrelracing.com.
- Riding slots will be offered Friday from 7pm-9pm and Saturday from 8:30am-10am. Friday riding slots MUST be pre-purchased via SaddleBook. Saturday riding slots will be offered as follows: 10-minute/4 rider limit, 15-minute/6 rider limit or 25-minute/12 rider limit. Slots are \$15 each. Saturday slots will be sold on-site ONLY, no exceptions starting at 8am Saturday! Selling of riding slots will be limited to 3 spots per person in line at the entry office. No ponying or leading horses during a riding slot.
- Futurity barrel exhibitions will be offered Saturday immediately after the Open barrels. \$15 each, limited to 2 per horse. These will be treated like timed runs, not training sessions. Sold onsite starting Saturday morning until 50 runners from the end of the open barrels.
- Pole bending exhibitions will be offered Saturday immediately after the Open/AQHA Saturday pole classes. Pole bending exhibitions will be sold onsite, starting at 8am Saturday and will be limited to 50 exhibitions total. Exhibitions will be \$5 each and limited to 3 per rider.
- Entering this race gives the official photographer, Kay Miller with Bunkhouse Blessings, permission to take pictures of and during all contestant's runs. Photographs will be made available for purchase via BunkhouseBlessingsPhotos.com. Furthermore, CBT Barrel Racing, has the right to use contestant's pictures for sponsor and race promotion purposes. Running Rules
 - In the event of a timer failure, a re-run will be offered. Penalties from the original run will NOT be applied to the re-run.
- · Horse/rider combos must compete in the order posted in the draw. A contestant will be given 3 gate calls. A contestant's first gate call is checking in with the gate person. When the announcer calls you into the arena, that will be your 2nd call. If you miss your run you will considered a no time. If you compete out of order, you will be given a no time.
- If you get off pattern, do not circle a barrel more than once. Keep the ground as good and fair as possible. Excessive abusive of arena time could result in a fine.
- · A barrel or pole that falls to the ground and has to be reset before the next runner will be considered knocked down and will result in a no time.
- · Holding pen requests The contestants that are in the front holding pen (waiting their turn to run) need to stand at the front of that pen to avoid a possible collision with the competing runner. After making your run, please exit the holding pen asap. Please do not get off your horse in the holding pen. These requests are for the safety of everyone.

Dress Code

• Dress code is required. This includes western hat or helmet, a long-sleeved shirt, pants and boots or riding shoes with heels. If contestant breaks dress code, they will receive a no time. There will be a hat fine of \$5 if the arena staff collects your hat. Fine is due to the staff member that collects your hat.

Complaints

• A contestant wishing to point out a discrepancy or file a complaint must do so with a CBT Barrel Racing official, accompanied by a \$50 fee. All complaints must be filed in a timely manner to be considered. If CBT Barrel Racing sides with the contestant on the discrepancy, the \$50 will be returned, however, if the organization disagrees with the complaint the \$50 will not be returned. The CBT Barrel Racing official's decision is final!

Open Payback and Race Format, Open Payback and Awards

- The Open will be a 5D race with ½ second splits. Saturday's open has \$1000 added, 75% payback and award choices to the Top 5 of each D. Sunday's open has \$2000 added with 80% payback.
- Day race payback scale will be: 1D--30%, 2D--25%, 3D--20%, 4D--15%, 5D--10%, with BBR suggested payoff percentages for the actual placings. Results will be calculated at the end of each day for that Day's race.
- Starting this year, the optional KoolSpeed Bonus Bucks race will have a \$10 entry fee with \$1000 added and 80% payback. The KoolSpeed Bonus race results will be calculated at the end of the weekend and will include all paid-in times from the Saturday and Sunday open barrels. Runners that run more than one day will have the opportunity to enter one or both runs and can place more than once in the Bonus race and can win multiple checks. The combined race payback will be equal payout in the Ds and equal payout in the placings (ie: bonus bucks). Awards (1 buckle and 4 \$100 Choice of Champions award certificates) and checks will be awarded to the Top 5 in each D of the KoolSpeed Bonus race.
- Award choice will be given first on presence or planned representation and secondly in order of placing. Any ties for awards will be broken first by presence or planned representation and secondly by draw of a chip.

3D Youth

- The 12 & under youth will be a 3D with full-second splits. Age is as of race day.
- \$40 entry fee, 80% payback, \$250 added each day and average awards, sponsored by Palo Duro Glamping.
- Youth will run first both days. The youth's run(s) can be carry-overs into the Open 5D and/or the SuperSized 4D sidepot with the appropriate paid fees.

18 & under 3D Youth sidepots

- Offered both Saturday and Sunday and offered for both barrels and poles. \$40 entry fee, 80% payback. Each event is a 3D with .75 splits.
 All-around awards offered for Saturday's combined times for the barrels and poles and for Sunday's combined time for the barrels and poles. All-around awards given on a 3D scale with 1.5-second splits.

Open 4D Poles

- Open 4D poles will have full second splits, 80% payback, \$40 entry fee. Average awards and \$100 added daily sponsored by Bunkhouse Blessings Photography.
- The Gambler 3D Pole Bending Sweepstakes a Bonus Race Finals qualifier
- \$35 required entry fee with every Sunday Open 4D pole bending entry. No payback for the qualifier. FMI, visit: https://bonusracefinals.com/polebending.html 707 \$uper\$ized 4D sidepot

 - Open to any entered contestant. Can only be entered as a carry-over from your Open 5D or Youth 3D run. No late fee to add the sidepot on-site BEFORE you run.
 The sidepot is a 3D, paid back on a Pro-D payback scale (Progressive-Divisional). The Pro-D is a straight pay for the 1D (paying double the number of places) with 2D and 3D divisions, all with .707 splits between the Ds. Payback is split 65% to the 1D, 20% to the 2D and 15% to the 3D. See previous year's results for payback examples, but we now have .707-second splits.
- \$150 entry fee, 90% payback. Saturday and Sunday will be paid back separately. You can enter one or both days. D-winner award certificates sponsored by Formula 707. 'Nifty 50' sidepot

- Open to contestants age 50 or older (as of race day). • 3D with 3/4 second splits, \$40 entry fee, 80% payback. Average awards sponsored by Green Chile Willy's Grill. AQHA Barrel and Pole classes
- - Amateur, Select Amateur, Youth, Junior & Senior classes offered both days for barrels and Amateur, Youth & Open classes offered both days poles. AQHA judge will be onsite and AQHA rules will be followed. AQHA classes will be drawn within the open, but, to save the judge time, AQHA barrel entries will be drawn later on Saturday and earlier on Sunday. • AQHA classes are pre-entry ONLY, no exceptions. All AQHA contestants MUST pick up their back # from the on-site office and compete with the # displayed. AQHA dress code includes long sleeve, button down, collared shirts.
- Average & Reserve Average awards, sponsored by Rustic Furniture Warehouse, will be awarded for all 8 classes.

Most Consistent Saddle & awards

• To encourage participation in our two Clovis NM race weekends (March 15-16 and Sept 6-7), we will be awarding a Most Consistent saddle. A horse/rider team's 3 closest open barrel or open pole times count (meaning you could get a NT on one run or not compete and still be eligible). A \$2000 Double J saddle certificate will be awarded. We will also have award buckle cups for the Most Consistent every 2 runs (March 15 & 16, March 16 & Sept 6 and Sept 6 & Sept 7). Awards sponsored by the City of Clovis.

Clovis Horse Sales incentive

- If an entered horse was purchased since 2017 through a Clovis Horse Sales sale, that horse is eligible for a \$150 high-point weekend bonus and the \$1000 year-end high point bonus. Horses MUST be nominated with CBT Barrel Racing at least 10 days prior to the first day of the weekend's race. Nomination forms can be found on www.CBTBarrelRacing.com and horse's eligibility will be verified with Clovis Horse Sales.
- Each entered horse will receive 5 points and the top 10 qualified times will be awarded bonus points of 10 points down to 1 point. Points will be awarded each day of a weekend race. Team Race - sponsored by the City of Clovis

Facility Rules

- Stalls & RVs will be taken via www.OpenStalls.com. Coggins will be checked by the facility for stalled horses. On-site facility office (for stalls and RVs) opens at 1pm Friday. Co-Approvals
 - BBR If you are a current BBR member and would like this race to count toward their finals, you must provide us with your membership number prior to running. If you wish to become a member you may purchase your membership in the entry office.
 - WPRA If you are a current WPRA member and would like to be included in the WPRA results, you must provide us with your membership number prior to running.
 - Run For The Bonus Visit www.BonusRaceFinals.com for qualifier information. No entry fee. Number of qualifiers is based on the number of entries. Only the Saturday and Sunday 'day' races are qualifiers. \$1 per open run goes to the Bonus Race Finals.
 - Diamond Classic Event registration form for the \$5000 added Diamond Classic bonus money can be found at www.TheDiamondClassic.com or on the CBT website.
 - PBRIP Visit https://apha.com/pbrip/about-pbrip/ for more information. \$200 added money sponsored by APHA. \$40 per run entry fee. PBRIP sidepot is offered both days, but paid out as one race. Horse/rider combos can place in the sidepot more than once.
