2019 Race 4 Ca\$h Rules

Entry and Draw Rules

• All pre-entries must be postmarked by February 20th. Entries after this date must pay a late fee of \$20 per rider, <u>per office visit</u>. Late entries will be taken until the first horse runs each day.

• On-line entries will be accepted via www.EBarrelRacing.com. See the website for more on-line entry information & details.

• Horse or rider substitutions will be allowed until the first horse runs each day with a \$10 change fee.

• Vet/Doctor releases will be accepted until 5pm Thursday March 7th. Full refund (less the processing fee) with valid release. Fax # for vet-outs is 806-488-2146, e-mail address is: office@cbtproductions.com.

• Open arena will be offered from 7am-8:45am Saturday. There is no charge for open arena. Absolutely NO barrels can be set up during open arena.

• Riding slots will be offered Saturday from 9am–1pm. Riding slots will be offered as follows: 10-minute/4 rider limit, 15-minute/6 rider limit or 25-minute/12 rider limit (no ponying or leading horses). Slots are \$15 each. Slots will be sold on-site ONLY, no exceptions! Selling of riding slots will be limited to 3 spots per person in line at the entry office.

• If you are a current BBR member and would like this race to count toward their finals, you must provide us with your membership number prior to running. If you wish to become a member you may purchase your membership in the entry office.

• If you are a current WPRA member and would like to be included in the WPRA results, you must provide us with your membership number prior to running.

• Entering this race gives the official photographer, Two Dog Enterprises, permission to take pictures of and during all contestant's runs. Photographs will be made available for purchase. Furthermore, CBT Productions LLC, has the right to use contestant's pictures for sponsor and race promotion purposes.

Running Rules

• In the event of a timer failure, a re-run will be issued. If a contestant decides to rerun, any penalties from the original run will be assessed.

• Horse/rider combos must compete in the order posted in the draw. A contestant will be given 3 gate calls. If you miss your run you will considered a no time. If you compete out of order, you will be given a no time.

• If you get off pattern, do not circle a barrel more than once. Keep the ground as good and fair as possible. Excessive abusive of arena time could result in a fine.

Dress Code

• Dress code is required. This includes western hat or helmet, a longsleeved shirt, pants and boots or riding shoes with heels. If contestant breaks dress code, they will receive a no time.

2019 RACE SCHEDULE

Saturday--March 9th

7am-8:45am--open arena (no charge, no barrels) 8am--Entry office opens 9am-1pm--riding slots 1:45pm--Race starts (3D youth, followed by the \$1500 added Open 5D Race #1, followed by any RBR qualifier runners that weren't carryovers)

Sunday--March 10th (daylight savings starts)

8am--Church

8am--Entry office opens 8:45am--Race starts (3D youth, followed by the \$1500 added Open 5D Race #1, followed by any RBR qualifier runners that weren't carryovers)

\$500 added 'Main' race (race #3) consists of all runs from race #1 and #2.

• There will be a hat fine of \$5 if the arena staff collects your hat. Fine is due to the staff member that collects your hat. Complaints

• A contestant wishing to point out a discrepancy or file a complaint must do so with a CBT Productions LLC official, accompanied by a \$50 fee. All complaints must be filed in a timely manner to be considered. If CBT Productions, LLC sides with the contestant on the discrepancy, the \$50 will be returned, however, if the organization disagrees with the complaint the \$50 will not be returned.

• The CBT Productions official's decision is final!

Open Payback and Race Format

• The open will be a 5D race with $\frac{1}{2}$ second splits.

• 75% of entry fees will go into purse. Of the purse money, 50% goes to that Day's Race and 50% to the Main Race.

• 100% of added money will go into purse. \$500 added to the Main Race (race #3) and \$1500 added to each of the Day Races (Saturday is race #1 and Sunday is race #2)

• Payback scale will be: 1D--30%, 2D--25%, 3D--20%, 4D--15%, 5D--10%, with a modified BBR suggested payoff percentages for the actual placings.

• Results will be calculated at the end of each day for that Day's race (Saturday is race #1 and Sunday is race #2). The Main race results will be calculated at the end of Sunday's open and will include all times from race #1 and #2. (Ex: If Saturday has 150 runners and Sunday has 175 runners, then the Main race will have 325 runners.) Runners that run more than one day will have more than one time in the Main race and can win multiple checks.

• Any unpaid money because of un-filled divisions will go to the winner of the 1D.

• For all other rules refer to BBR/NBHA/WPRA rules.

Awards

• Choice of certificates from the merchants in our Choice of Champions award program will be given to the Top 5 of each division of the Main Race. 1st place will win a \$100 certificate, 2nd place will win an \$80 certificate, 3rd place will win a \$60 certificate, 4th place will win a \$40 certificate and 5th place will win a \$20 certificate.

• Any ties for awards will be broken first by presence or representation and secondly by draw of a chip.

3D Youth

• The youth will be a 3D with full-second splits. Age limit is 15. Age is as of race day.

• \$25 entry fee, 80% payback. Awards to be determined.

• Youth will run not before 1:45pm on Saturday and not before 8:45am Sunday. The youth's run(s) can be carry-overs into the open with the appropriate paid fees.

Revolution Barrel Racing finals qualifier sanctioned sidepot

• Open to any RBR member. Membership can be pre-purchased via www.RevolutionRaces.com or purchased on-site.

• The sidepot is a 4D with 1/2 second splits. \$150 entry fee, 80% payback. Saturday and Sunday will be combined into one payout. Payout will completed by RBR.

• The sidepot can be entered as a carry-over from your Open run(s) or it can be a separate run. Any runners not carrying over from the open will run at the end of the day race.

<u>Stalls & RVs</u>

• Stalls and RVs will be handled by the facility and on-site only. \$20 covered stalls (limited supply), \$10 uncovered stalls, \$20 RV spots. You can bring your own shavings.
